## Food Concession Regulations

TUESDAY, JULY 25 to SUNDAY, July 30, 2017

**IMPORTANT NOTICE: Only bottles of PEPSI products are permitted.**

1. If you do not already have a food vendor's permit, please complete the enclosed **Application for Temporary Event Food Permit**. Return the Application & License Fee to the address listed on the Temporary Event Food Permit **Application at least two weeks in advance to the start date of the Exhibition.**
2. **FINAL DATE FOR RECEIVING CONCESSION APPLICATIONS AND PAYMENT is June 2, 2017.** After this date the Exhibition reserves the right to rent your space to another vendor.
3. **Concessions must adhere to Lunenburg County's Municipal Recycling Centres, rules for Disposing of Waste (attached).**
4. Concession **cleanliness** is the Exhibitor's responsibility.
5. All improvements made by concession holders become property of the Exhibition if not removed by **August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017.**
6. Security is the concession's responsibility. The Exhibition **will not be responsible for loss of goods and/or equipment due to fire, theft, etc.**
7. NO concession can be TRANSFERRED or SUB-LET without permission of the Exhibition.
8. Deliveries on the grounds are allowed up to **12:00 noon.**
9. Loud speakers and excessive noise not permitted.
10. Concessions must **be ready for the public by 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 25,** and must remain **OPEN until 5:00 p.m. Sunday, July 30, 2017.**
11. All products to be sold must be listed on the attached form unless okayed by Exhibition Management.
12. **PEPSI** is the official soft drink of the South Shore Exhibition. Please use bottled PEPSI products **ONLY** for beverages.
13. No smoking in food area.
14. **CONCESSIONS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE 3 (THREE) FIRE EXTINGUISHERS IN BOOTHS AT ALL TIMES WHERE FRYERS & GRILLS ARE USED, AND 1 (ONE) IN ALL OTHERS.**

**ANOTHER REGULATION IS REGARDING “MEAT PRODUCTS” THAT ARE SOLD IN CONCESSIONS. ALL MEAT PRODUCTS SOLD MUST BE FROM A GOVERNMENT INSPECTED FACILITY. YOU MAY HAVE TO PROVIDE THE INSPECTORS PROOF OF WHERE YOU PURCHASED YOUR PRODUCT.**

**Important Notice to ALL Vendors  
“Recycling Policies at the South Shore Exhibition”**

**Recycling is no longer something you should do ... it is something you MUST do!**

As everyone is aware, the Lunenburg Regional Recycling Centre has become much stricter in receiving unsorted waste at their facility. Fines and penalties are enforced when unsorted waste from the same location continues to arrive at the Centre.

The South Shore Exhibition is a large Fair and we generate a lot of waste during our 6 day event. With over 45,000 people attending, every effort must be made by everyone to recycle. Food Concessions generate a lot of waste and people using these concessions are some of the ones less likely to recycle. If the Exhibition receives fines for waste that has not been recycled, the cost eventually works its way down to those who create the waste.

Concessions will be asked to implement and improve their recycling program. Every concession must have at least one sorting station by their eating establishment. People working in the concession are encouraged to tell their customers to “Please Recycle”. A sorting station must have 3 containers in each station.

We would ask that concessions use paper products ONLY when at all possible. Paper plates and dishes, parchment paper, cardboard containers, paper coffee cups, etc., **Styrofoam is one of the evils of recycling and makes everyone’s job much harder.**

We have attached a copy of a pamphlet regarding **Deep Fry Fat**. If you do not have someone who collects your fryer fat, there are two telephone numbers on the pamphlet of people who will come and collect it and properly dispose of it.

**Cardboard boxes** must be broken down and placed outside your Concession for the Exhibition employees to put in the proper containers.

Your full cooperation with regards to recycling is greatly appreciated. Not only are we helping the environment, but we are also helping to keep our Exhibition grounds clean and presentable for the public.
